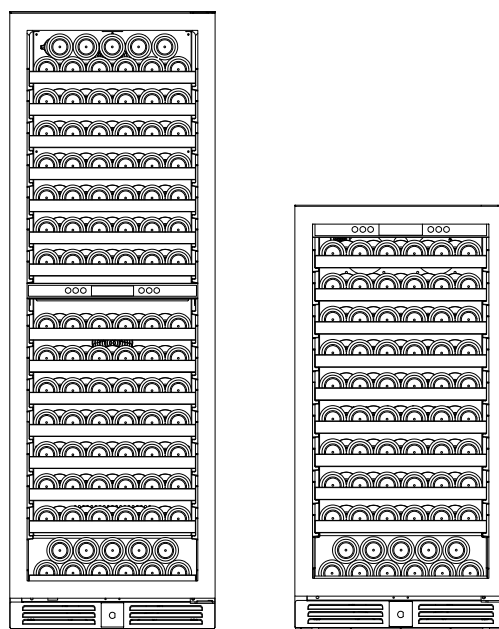

WINE CHILLER

WARNING

- To prevent damaging the door gasket, make sure to have the door all the way opened when pulling shelves out of the rail compartment.
- The appliance must be positioned so that the plug is accessible. Release the electric cord. Move your cabinet to its final location. Do not move your Cabinet while loaded with wine. You might distort the body. The wine cellar should be installed in a suitable place in order to avoid touching the compressor with hand.
- This appliance is not intended for use by persons (including children) with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities or lack of experience and knowledge, unless they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the appliance by a person responsible for their safety.
- If the supply cord is damaged, it must be replaced by manufacturer of its Service agent or a similarly qualified person in order to avoid a hazard.

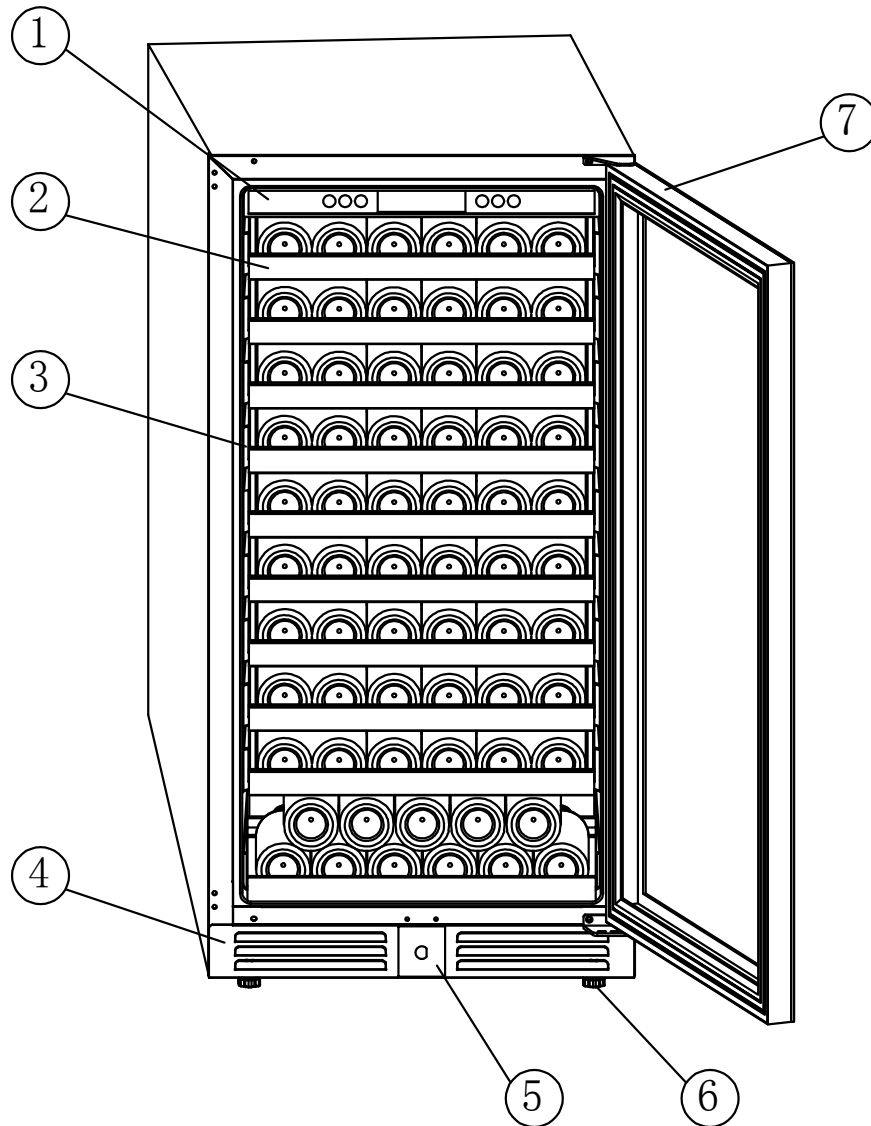

Junked or abandoned appliances are still dangerous even if they will "just sit in the garage a few days". • Before you throw away your old Wine chiller: Take off the door. Leave the shelves in place so that children may not easily climb inside. • Never allow children to operate, play with, or crawl inside the appliance. • Never clean appliance parts with flammable fluids. The fumes can create a fire hazard or explosion. • Do not store or use gasoline or any other flammable vapors and liquids in the vicinity of this or any other appliance. The fumes can create a fire hazard or explosion. Do not store explosive substances such as aerosol cans with a flammable propellant in this appliance.

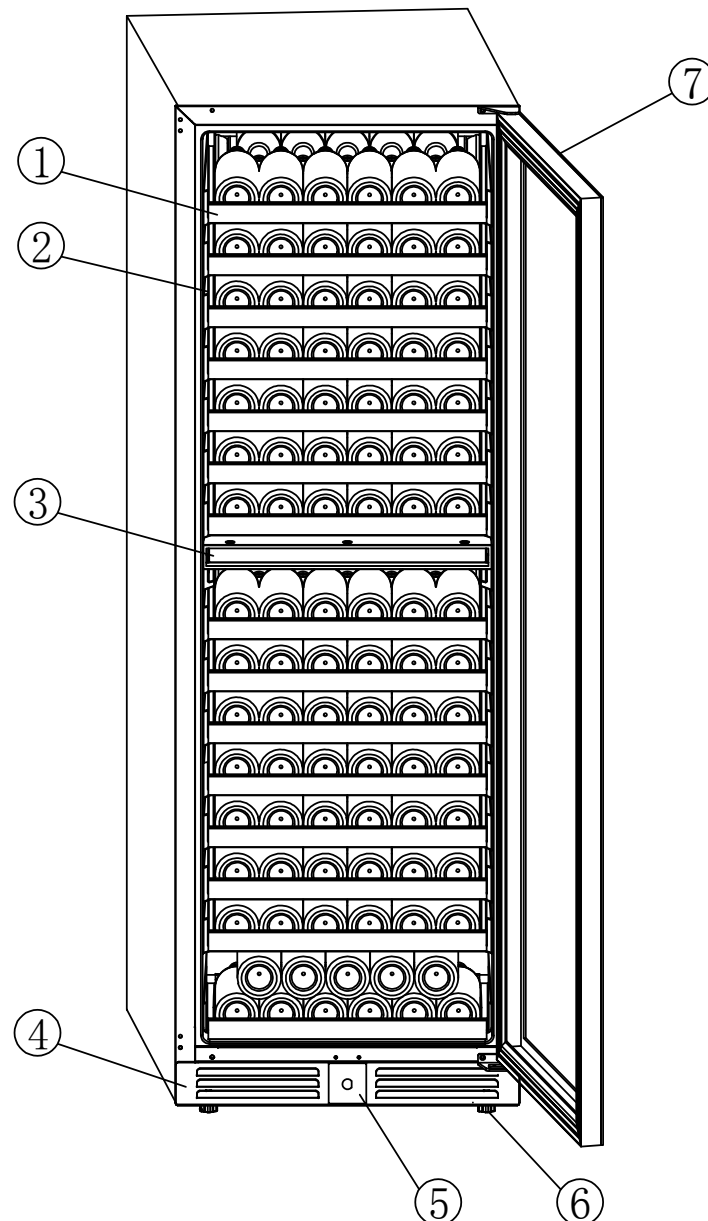

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

➤ **Before Using Your Wine chiller**

- Remove the exterior and interior packing.
- Before connecting the Wine chiller to the power source, let it stand upright for approximately 2 hours. This will reduce the possibility of a malfunction in the cooling system from handling during transportation.
- Clean the interior surface with lukewarm water using a soft cloth.
- This appliance is intended to be used in household and similar applications such as
 - staff kitchen areas in shops, offices and other working environments;
 - farm houses and by clients in hotels, motels and other residential type environments;
 - bed and breakfast type environments;
 - catering and similar non-retail applications.
- When disposing your appliance, please choose an authorized disposal site.

➤ **Installation of Your Wine Chiller**

- This appliance is designed to be for free standing installation or built-in (fully recessed) (Refer to sticker location the back of this appliance).
- **This appliance is intended to be used exclusively for the storage of wine or beverages.**
- Place your wine chiller on a floor that is strong enough to support it when it is fully loaded. To level your wine chiller, adjust the front leveling leg at the bottom of the wine chiller.
- This appliance is using flammability refrigerant. So never damage the cooling pipework during the transportation. Locate the wine chiller away from direct sunlight and sources of heat (stove, heater, radiator, etc.). Direct sunlight may affect the acrylic coating and heat sources may increase electrical consumption. Extreme cold ambient temperatures may also cause the unit not to perform properly.
- Avoid locating the unit in moist areas.
- Plug the wine chiller into an exclusive, properly installed-grounded wall outlet. Do not under any circumstances cut or remove the third (ground) prong from the power cord. Any questions concerning power and/or grounding should be directed toward a certified electrician or an authorized Products service center.

➤ **Attention**

- Store wine in sealed bottles;
- Do not overload the appliance;
- Do not open the door unless necessary;
- Do not cover shelves with aluminum foil or any other shelf material which may prevent air circulation;
- Should the wine chiller be stored without use for long periods it is suggested, after a careful cleaning, to leave the door ajar to allow air to circulate inside the cabinet in order to avoid possible formations of condensation, mold or odors.

➤ **Ambient Room Temperature Limits**

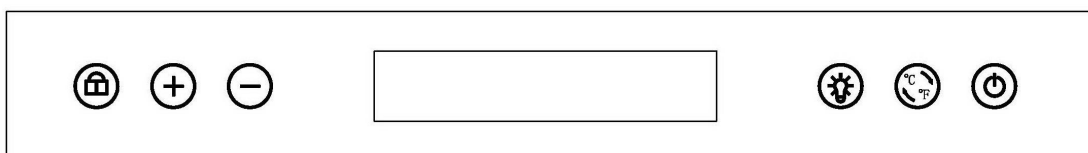

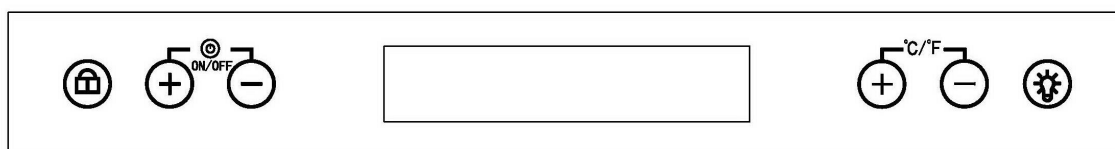
➤ Control System Instruction



- Temperature control range: 5-20°C (41-68°F)
- Press  3 seconds to unlock/lock all the buttons. If there is no any operation within 15 seconds after unlock, the buttons will be locked automatically.
- Press  to increase the interior setting temperature.
- Press  to decrease the interior setting temperature.
- Short press  to turn on or off, Long Press  to change the colors. The colors selection are Pure White, Warm White, Ice Blue, Purple, Blue, Green, Red.
- Press  for 3 seconds to change the temperature display between °C and °F.
- Press  for 3 seconds to power on or off the unit.

➤ Control System Instruction



Temperature control range: Upper zone 5-12°C (41-54°F), lower zone 12-20°C (54-68°F)

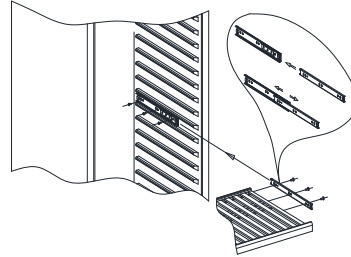
- Press  3 seconds to unlock/lock all the buttons. If there is no any operation within 15 seconds after unlock, the buttons will be locked automatically.
- Press left  or  to adjust the temperature of upper zone.
- Press right  or  to adjust the temperature of lower zone.
- Press left  and  at the same time for 3 seconds to power on/off.
- Press right  and  at the same time for 3 seconds to switch between °C and °F.
- Short press  to turn on or off, Long Press  to change the colors. The colors selection are Pure White, Warm White, Ice Blue, Purple, Blue, Green, Red.

➤ **Attention**

- If the unit is unplugged, power lost, or turned off, you must wait 3 to 5 minutes before restart the unit. If you need attempt to restart before this time delay, the wine chiller will not start. If first time use or longer absence of using, the temperature will difference between setting and LED display temperature. After running a period, the temperature will be reverting back.

➤ **Pull-out Roller Shelves**

- To prevent damaging the door gasket, make sure to have the door all the way opened when pulling shelves out of the rail compartment.
- For easy access to the bottles, you must pull the shelves approximately 1/3 out of the rail compartment.



- To remove the shelves out of the rail, pull each shelf approximately 1/3 out. Use a long flat screwdriver to press down the right plastic notch as shown in Figure A and at the same time lift the left plastic notch as shown in Figure B. Then proceed to pull out the shelf slowly. Contact our service department if assistance is needed.

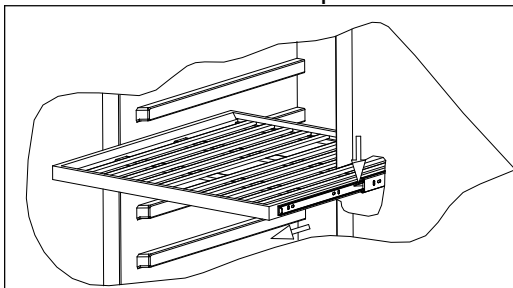

UNPACKING AND CLEANING THE wine chiller

Remove the exterior and interior packing materials.

Let the appliance stand upright for approximately 2 hours before connecting it to the power source, which helps to reduce the possibility of a cooling-system malfunction from handling during transportation.

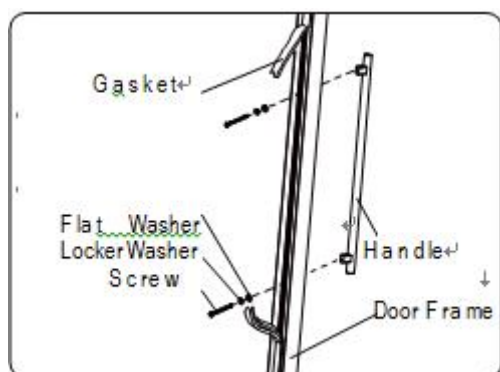
Use a soft cloth to clean the interior surface with lukewarm water.

Install the door handle provided with the appliance by following these steps:

Step 1 — Remove the gasket at the inner side of the door to expose the two screw holes.

Step 2 — Install the handle tightly with the screws and washers provided.

Step 3 — Tidy and restore the gasket.



LOCK & UNLOCK THE DOOR

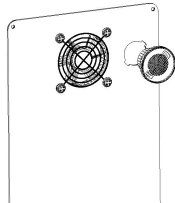
Insert the key into the lock and turn it counter-clockwise to unlock the door. To lock it, please follow the reversed operation. Please save the key well.

CHARCOAL FILTRATION SYSTEM

Your wine is a living object that breathes through the cork of its bottle. In order to preserve the quality and taste of your fine wines, they must be stored at the ideal temperature and ambient conditions. Your cellar is equipped with an active charcoal filtration system to ensure air purity, cooling efficiency, and to maintain an odor free cabinet for the storage of your fine wines. The filter assembly is located at the rear panel inside your cellar.

Keep in mind, that this filter must be changed every 12 months.

To replace your filter:

1	Remove the bottles of wine stored on the two (2) shelves in front of the filter.	
2	Remove the shelves and set aside to be replaced once you have changed the filter	
3	Hold the filter and turn it at 45 degrees in the counter-clockwise direction and then pull it out.	
4	Remove the existing filter and replace with a new one.	
5	Put the new filter into the hole and then turn the filter at 45 degrees in clockwise direction.	

Turn Left to remove filter.

CARE & MAINTENANCE

➤ **Clean your wine chiller**

Turn off the power, unplug the appliance, and remove all items including shelves and rack. Wash the inside surfaces with a warm water and mild solution.

Wash the shelves with a mild detergent solution.

Wring excess water out of the sponge or cloth when cleaning area of the controls, or any electrical parts.

Wash the outside cabinet with warm water and mild liquid detergent. Rinse well and wipe dry with a clean soft cloth.

➤ **Power failure**

Most power failures are corrected within a few hours and should not affect the temperature of your appliance if you minimize the number of times the door is opened. If the power is going to be off for a long period of time, you need to take the proper steps to protect your contents.

➤ **Vacation Time**

Short vacations: Leave the wine chiller operating during vacations of less than three weeks.

If the appliance will not be used for several months, remove all items and turn off the appliance. Clean and dry the interior thoroughly. To prevent odor and mold growth, leave the door open slightly: blocking it open if necessary.

➤ **Moving your wine chiller:**

Remove all items.

Take out the loose items inside the wine chiller (such as shelf), or fix the loose items with the foam.

Turn the adjustable leg up to the base to avoid damage.

Tape the door shut.

Be sure the appliance stays secure in the upright position during transportation. Also protect outside of appliance with a blanket or similar items.

➤ **Energy saving tips**

The wine chiller should be located in the coolest area of the room, away from producing appliances, and out of the direct sunlight.

Before disposal of the appliance.

1. Disconnect the main plug from the main socket.
2. Cut off the main cable and discard it.

PROBLEMS WITH YOUR WINE CHILLER

You can solve many common wine chiller problems easily, saving you the cost of a possible service call. Try the suggestions below to see if you can solve the problem before calling the servicer.

Troubleshooting Guide

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Chiller does not operate	Not plugged in. The appliance is turned off. The circuit breaker tripped or a blown fuse.	Plug the unit. Turn on the unit. Check the breaker and/or fuses.
Chiller is not cold enough	Check the temperature control setting. External environment may require a higher setting. The door is opened too often. The door is not closed completely. The door gasket does not seal properly.	Check the temperature control setting. Close the door properly. Check the door gasket.
Turns on and off frequently	The room temperature is hotter than normal. Overload of the cabinet The door is opened too often. The door is not closed completely. The temperature control is not set correctly. The door gasket does not seal properly.	Close the door properly. Check the door gasket.
The light does not work	Not plugged in. The circuit breaker tripped or a blown fuse. The bulb has burned out. The light button is "OFF"	Plug the unit. Check the breaker and/or fuses. Turn on the light
Vibrations	The chiller is not levelled The bottles are vibrating. There is an object under the chiller.	Check to assure that the chiller is level. Make sure the bottles don't touch each other. Remove the object.
Too much noise	The Chiller is not level.	Level the chiller. The rattling noise may come from the flow of the refrigerant, which is normal. As each cycle ends, you may hear gurgling. Contraction and expansion of the inside walls may cause popping and crackling noises.
The door will not close properly	The Chiller is not level. The door was reversed and not properly installed. The gasket is dirty. The shelves are out of position.	Level the chiller. Close the door properly. Clean the door gasket. Place the shelves properly.
